

Town of Bassendean Waste and Recycling Guide 2023 - 2024



Place two bins out for collection each week:



Keep bins one metre clear of obstructions and within one metre of the road.

- FOGO (lime green lid) + RECYCLING (yellow lid) week
- FOGO (lime green lid) + GENERAL WASTE (red lid) week
- Bins collected a day later due to public holiday.
- Additional Christmas Collections, all three bins collected during this period.

MATTRESSES, FRIDGES AND LOUNGES

Call **9350 7195** to book a collection and place items on verge as directed.

Please remember to:

- ✓ Remove the door from fridges and freezers before placing on verge.
- ✓ Fridges and freezers do not need to be degassed prior to collection.
- ✓ Limit of 3 mattresses, lounges and fridges per year.

Each financial year, property owners are eligible to receive two (2) tip passes. They can be picked up from 35 Old Perth Road or be mailed out by request. Please contact the Town on **9377 8000**.

BOOKED SKIP BINS

Each financial year, residents will be eligible to order

- 1x General Waste skip bin
- and
- 1x Greenwaste skip bin.

Skip bins are 1.8m long x 1.65m wide x 1.2m tall

- Bokashi Bucket + 1kg mix \$38.00
- Worm Farm + 1kg worms \$56.00
- 220L Compost Bin \$24.00

Cloth nappy & sanitary rebates

- Nappies - up to \$100.00
- Sanitary - up to \$50.00
